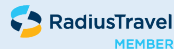

### Transport Canada To Conduct Flight Test For Boeing 737 MAX:

Transport Canada plans to conduct flight test activities for the validation of Boeing Co's grounded 737 MAX next week, the regulator told Reuters on Thursday, as part of global efforts to return the plane to service following two fatal crashes involving the model. Transport Canada is said to be the first non-U.S. regulator to conduct such activities, following test flights performed earlier this summer by the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) which is tasked with certifying the aircraft.

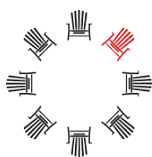

IATA has warned travellers risk penalties for refusing to wear face masks on flights amid concern that passengers flouting health measures could deter others from flying. Airline association IATA issued the warning late on Monday and appealed to all travellers "to wear face coverings during the travel journey".

Delta is extending one of the key health and safety protocols this winter holiday season by blocking the selection of middle seats and limiting the number of customers per flight through at least Jan. 6, 2021.

### PAL Airlines Announces Service To Moncton And Ottawa:

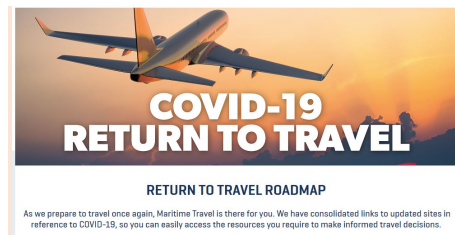
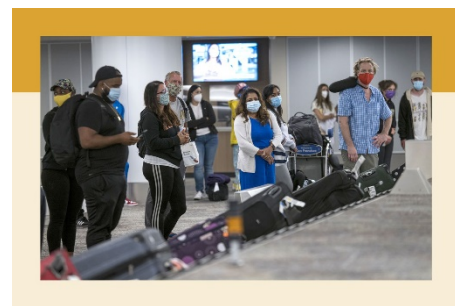

### CDC Drops 14-Day Self-Quarantine Recommendation For International And Out-Of-State Travelers (in the United States):

Since March, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has advised travelers to

self-quarantine for 14 days after all international travel, and after domestic travel to states seeing a high rate of coronavirus cases. But the CDC has changed that stance, removing the directions for two-week quarantines from the "After You Travel" section of its coronavirus travel guidance.
