Reminder - New Requirements For Travel To Canada: For travellers arriving to Canada by land, as of February 15, 2021, all travellers, with some exceptions, will be required to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 molecular test result taken in the United States within 72 hours of pre-arrival, or a positive test taken 14 to 90 days prior to arrival. In addition, as of February 22, 2021, travellers entering Canada at the land border will be required to take a COVID-19 molecular test on arrival as well as toward the end of their 14-day quarantine.



Entering Canada by Air During COVID-19: Travellers entering Canada must follow the rules set out by the Emergency Orders under the Quarantine Act to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and its variants. Failure to comply with any requirements or providing false information may result in fines, penalties or imprisonment.



Flair Announces Plans To Add Eight Domestic Routes As Other Airlines Cut Service: Low-cost carrier Flair Airlines says it is expanding service to eight cities in Canada, bringing its number of domestic destinations to 18 by the summer. Starting May 1, Flair will expand service to Ottawa, Kitchener-Waterloo, Halifax and Saint John, N.B. Flair will also add service to Thunder Bay, Ont., and Charlottetown in June, to Victoria in July and to Abbotsford, B.C., in August.



Air Canada Goodwill Policy: Air Canada has implemented a Goodwill policy for rebooking passengers with any itineraries with a final destination to Canada or with onward connections within Canada who are laying over due to the new testing requirements in YYZ/YVR/YUL/YYC. Customers are permitted changes per the guidelines below:

- 1 free change – Pre-departure before arrival into Canada
- 1 free change – At YYZ/YVR/YUL/YYC for domestic sector
