Important Changes To The COVID-19 Testing Trial At YYC: As of January 25, border pilot participants must now remain in quarantine until receiving a negative result from their second test on day 7 or 8 (counting arrival day as day 1). Travellers currently in the program must immediately return to quarantine if they haven't taken their second test and received the negative result yet. Participants cannot return to childcare, out of school care, schools, post-secondary institutions, and workplaces outside of their home for 14 days.



Canada-U.S. Border To Remain Closed Until At Least Feb. 21: The Canada-U.S. border will remain closed to non-essential travel until at least Feb. 21. Public Safety Minister Bill Blair today announced the latest extension to international travel restrictions to prevent the spread of COVID-19. The Canada-U.S. agreement bars entry to most travellers who are not Canadian citizens, permanent residents or

people entering from the U.S. for "essential" reasons.



WestJet Returns 737 MAX to Service, Pax Express Confidence in Recertification: Nearly two years after being grounded worldwide following two deadly crashes, the Boeing 737 MAX returned to Canadian airspace Thursday morning. WestJet is the first Canadian carrier to resume passenger service aboard the MAX with the departure of flight WS115 from Calgary to Vancouver on 21JAN. A second flight from Vancouver to Calgary followed later that day.

United States Testing And International Air Travel: To reduce introduction and spread of new variants of SARS-CoV-2, CDC issued an Order effective January 26, 2021. It requires all air passengers arriving to the US from a foreign country to get tested for COVID-19 infection no more than 3 days before their flight departs and to provide proof of the negative result or documentation of having recovered from COVID-19 to the airline before boarding the flight. New Delta.Com Tool Helps Customers Find Approved COVID-19 Testing Centers Across International Network: Following a new order from the Centers for Disease Control, Delta is helping customers around the world obtain approved COVID-19 tests prior to their travel to the U.S. Starting Jan. 26, 2021, all customers over the age of two entering or transiting through the U.S. from any location outside of the U.S. must obtain a negative test result from a viral test taken within three days of departure.
