### Government Of Canada Extends Quarantine Measures And Travel Restrictions:

The Government of Canada takes a prudent and responsible approach at the border, by continually monitoring and reviewing available data and scientific evidence to protect the health and safety of Canadians. Today, the Government of Canada is extending the temporary travel measures restricting entry into Canada by foreign nationals until June 21, 2021.



### No Date On Loosening Travel Restrictions, Vaccine Passports: Canada's Transport Minister:

Transport Minister Omar Alghabra says he cannot yet commit to a date for when so-called vaccine passports will happen in Canada — or the COVID-19 vaccination rate benchmarks that will allow Canada to ease travel restrictions. Alghabra has also stressed the need for a “common platform” to identify travellers’ vaccination status, saying Thursday he is working with G7 countries and the European Union to integrate

vaccine certification into international travel in the months ahead.



### Central Mountain Air To Provide Air Service Between Grande Prairie And Edmonton:

The Grande Prairie Airport will have a new partner providing air service in the coming weeks. Smithers, B.C., based Central Mountain Air will begin servicing the city of Edmonton with regular flights, one step further along in getting travellers back into the sky as the COVID-19 pandemic put a stop to regular flights into the provincial capital.



### Flight Restart Date For Saint John Airport Pushed Back, More Airlines Added:

The restart date for flights out of Saint John Airport has been pushed back again ahead of New Brunswick's reopening-plan announcements, with flights out of YSJ now scheduled to resume on June 30. The restart date, which was previously set at June 1, has always been a bit of a moving target because of the shifting COVID-

19 landscape, acting CEO Greg Hierlihy said in an interview Tuesday.
