Reminder: Using ArriveCAN To Enter Canada: Starting November 21, 2020, it is mandatory for all incoming travellers to Canada to provide travel and contact information, their quarantine plan and a COVID-19 symptom self-assessment upon and after entry into the country. Travellers can submit their information digitally via the [ArriveCAN website](#) or by downloading the app.



Delta, WestJet Scrap Planned Joint Venture After U.S. Demands: Delta Air Lines and Canada's WestJet said late on Friday they had scrapped a proposed U.S.-Canada joint venture after the U.S. government demanded changes the airlines insisted were "unreasonable and unacceptable". Last month, the U.S. Transportation Department as part of its tentative antitrust immunity approval said it


would require the carriers to remove Swoop, an ultra-low-cost carrier affiliate of WestJet, from the alliance, and divest 16 takeoff and landing slots at New York's LaGuardia Airport.



Qatar Airways Signs Air Canada Codeshare Deal: Qatar Airways has finalised a codeshare agreement with Air Canada applicable for travel between Doha and Toronto. Sales have started, with the first codeshare flights to operate from December 15th. The agreement is designed to reinforce Qatar Airways' commitment to Canadian passengers, and to boost Canada's global connectivity.



European Regulator To Lift Boeing 737 MAX Grounding in January: Europe is set to lift its flight ban on the Boeing 737 MAX passenger jetliner in January after U.S. regulators last week ended a 20-month grounding triggered by two fatal crashes.



COVID-Infected Flights Fall Sharply Across Canada: Only five international and six domestic flights with passengers infected with COVID-19 landed at Canadian airports last week. That's compared to 44 international and 60 domestic flights recorded the week previous, according to publicly available data from Health Canada.
