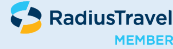

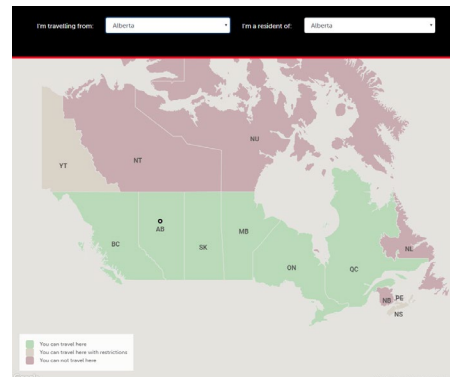


Reminder IATA Regulation for Traveller Contact Information:

The International Air Transport Association (IATA) is the trade association for the world's airlines, representing some 290 airlines or 82% of total air traffic. IATA supports airline activity and helps formulate industry policy and standards. On June 1, 2019, the new regulations of IATA Resolution 830d will enter into force. These changes mean that travel agents will be obligated to actively request and enter the travelers' contact information for every flight booking. The contact information will be provided to the airlines in order for the airline to contact the passenger directly in the event of any flight modifications and to be able to inform them about flight changes. 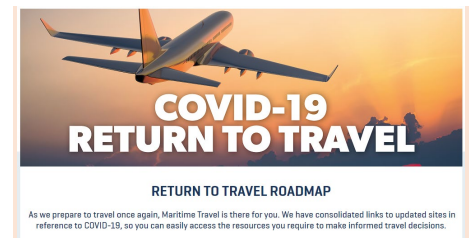
