Canada Is Easing Travel Rules On September 07. Here's What You Need To Know: International travellers who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 will once again be allowed onto Canadian soil this week as eased travel restrictions go into effect. At 12:01 a.m. Sept. 7, all foreign nationals who have been jabbed with a vaccine authorized for use by Health Canada will be allowed into the country for non-essential purposes, and won't need to quarantine for 14 days.



KLM Increases Canada Services As Travel Restrictions Ease: Canada has finally opened up to international travelers after shutting down non-essential travel since the beginning of the pandemic. After opening up to fully vaccinated US citizens in August, the country has now eased restrictions on vaccinated travelers from around the globe. In response, KLM will increase its services to Canada starting today, together with its Canadian partner WestJet.



Air Canada Rouge Returns to The Skies: Air Canada Rouge, Air Canada's leisure airline, resumed service today with flights operating between Toronto and Las Vegas, Orlando, and Regina, with other destinations being introduced in September, including Cancun and Tampa. Air Canada Rouge also provided a sneak peek of the cabin interior that will be available on nine Airbus A321 aircraft of the 39-aircraft Rouge Fleet, with the first entering service later this fall.



Air Canada's New 'Travel Ready Hub' Provides Destination Entry Requirements, Interactive Map For Travellers: Air Canada has unveiled its new 'Travel Ready Hub,' which will provide travellers with destination entry requirements and an interactive map to help prepare for upcoming trips. Through the Hub, customers can obtain information such as necessary travel documentation, COVID-19 test requirements and country travel restrictions for any global destination. Use ArriveCAN To Enter Canada: Use ArriveCAN to provide mandatory travel information before and after your entry into Canada. It only takes minutes to help keep each other safe. All travellers, with limited exceptions, whether entering Canada by air, land or marine vessel, must use ArriveCAN. You'll need to submit your information within 72 hours before your arrival to Canada.
